Council Corner

Council met on February 15, 2024. Here are the highlights of that meeting:

- We will host a community Maundy Thursday service during Holy Week.
- We are exploring the possibility of starting a daycare in collaboration with New Era Christian School.
- The New Era Farmer's Market will expand to 8 markets this summer.
- Plans were approved to expand the parking lot and build a handrail along the sidewalk to the outdoor worship.
- Pastor John, Dave Zoller, and Carole Giberson were delegated to the February meeting of Classis Muskegon.

At a retreat on Saturday, February 17, Council approved the following goals for 2024.

- 1. **Strengthen our care ministries.** Council will review the role and function of church families, strengthen elder visitation and pastoral care, and grow diaconal attention to benevolence and stewarding the gifts of the congregation and the community.
- 2. **Improve safe church practices.** Council, through the Safe Church Team, will update the safe church policy to reflect our current ministry reality and bring us up to date with best practices and training opportunities.
- 3. Continue to work toward a sustainable Latino church plant. Council, through the Latino Outreach Steering Committee, will work with community partners, secure financial support and partner churches, and begin reaching out to potential church planters.
- 4. Begin conversations about improvement to church building and grounds.
